Commentary on Corpus Christi by St. Thomas Aquinas

Under the old law it was the flesh of calves and goats that was offered, but here Christ himself, the true God, is set before us as our food. What could be more wonderful than this?

CALLING ALL PARISHIONERS


As the current parish year draws to a close at the end of June, we reach out to invite you to put your name forward or nominate a fellow parishioner to

30 Hour Eucharistic Adoration June 11 at 6 am - June 12 at 12 noon


For the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, we invite parishioners to come and spend some
