The first cenacle will be held on Tuesday, September 14th following the 7 pm Mass and will last about an hour, led by Fr. Joseph Moncada who is the Spiritual Director for the Legion of Mary, Toronto Senatus. Everyone is invited to attend. Registration is not required.

Explanation: In her messages to Fr. Gobbi, Our Lady insistently calls - priests, religious and faithful - to gather together with her in fervent prayer and fraternal love, in authentic cenacles as when the first apostles gathered with her in the Upper Room in Jerusalem awaiting the First Pentecost. Why this insistence? What is most important in the world and in the Church today is the preparation for the Second Pentecost through the triumph of her Immaculate Heart.

Structure: The cenacle is comprised of the recitation of the Most Holy Rosary, Holy Hour and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament, and reading and commentary on Our Lady's messages contained in the book "To the Priests our Lady's Beloved Sons."

Date and Time: After September 14th, all future cenacles will take place on the first Tuesday of the month following the 7 pm Mass and will run for about an hour.
