## <u>Updates to the Worship Safe Protocols</u> <u>Taking Effect March 2022</u>

### St. Mark's Church will be gradually and steadily implementing the new Worship Safe Protocols.

- While capacity restrictions have been lifted, our parish will move steadily and deliberately, but a little more cautiously, back to full capacity over the coming weeks and, please God, we will be back at full capacity for Easter.
- We are doing so in order to provide greater confidence and security for those who have already returned to church over the last month or so but might feel hesitant to see an overnight return to full normalcy and thus withdraw and hold off continuing coming to mass.
- Therefore, we will also be asking our parishioners to maintain a reduced social distance of 1 metre between distinct social bubbles/persons for the next few weeks.
- Weekly capacity increases will not involve a total single jump back to full capacity. Last week, we targeted a capacity of 175 and this weekend, we have moved to 200.
- For the above reasons, we will continue using the **Eventbrite registration process through March** and hopefully, then drop this in April. Please continue to visit the parish website to register.
- Livestreaming of the Sunday 9 am Mass will continue until April at which point it will stop.
- As of March 21<sup>st</sup>, Ontario will no longer mandate mask use, self-isolation for Covid-exposed people or symptom screening requirements. Masks will become optional when attending mass.
- Reception of Holy Communion on the tongue has now resumed. Please come to Fr. Michael at the front centre aisle after all other parishioners have received the Eucharist.
- The kiss of peace is still discouraged at this time. A bow or wave should continue to be used as an alternative.
- Holy water fonts have now been refilled.
- As we move into this new stage, please be patient.
   With our combined efforts, we can serve each other
   through compassion and understanding. Many of
   our parishioners will have different reactions to the
   removal of these restrictions and we must be
   respectful of all who enter the church.
