Sacred Heart of Jesus



Following the month of May in which we honour our Mother Mary, the month of June is dedicated to our strong devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Of all devotions, this particular devotion to the Sacred Heart has historically been, and continues to be, one of the most popular and widespread devotions here in the Archdiocese of

Toronto, and for all Catholics worldwide. According to Vatican News: "The Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is celebrated on the Friday after the Solemnity of Corpus Christi. This year it will take place on June 16. This suggests to us that the Eucharist (Corpus Christi) is none other than the Heart of Jesus himself, of the One who "takes care of us" with his "heart". On 20 October 1672, Father Giovanni Eudes, a priest from Normandy, celebrated this feast for the first time. But to popularize the devotion, the revelations of our Lord to a nun of the convent of Paray-le-Monial, Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690), contributed greatly. On 27 December 1673, Margaret Mary received the first vision of Jesus. He told her, "My Divine Heart is so passionately in love with humanity that it can no longer contain within itself the flames of its ardent love. It must pour them out. I have chosen you for this great plan," Jesus told her. The following year, Margaret Mary had two other visions. In the first, Jesus's heart was on a throne enveloped in flames brighter than the sun and more transparent than crystal, surrounded by a crown of thorns. In the other, she saw Christ shining in glory. Flames of fire were coming out of every part of his chest to the point that it looked like a furnace. Jesus spoke to her and asked her to receive Communion every first Friday for nine consecutive months and to prostrate herself on the ground for an hour the night between Thursday and Friday. This is how the practice of the nine first Fridays originated and the Holy Hour of Adoration. Then in a fourth vision, Christ asked for the institution of a feast to honour his Heart and to make reparation through prayer for offenses received.
