

### **Easter Obligation (Duty)**



The Easter obligation is the grave duty that every Catholic must receive Holy Communion during the Easter season, which concludes at Pentecost. A person should also prepare themselves by going to Confession before receiving the Eucharist. In the

sacrament of the most Holy Eucharist is contained truly, really, and substantially the Body and Blood, together with the Soul and Divinity, of our Lord Jesus Christ, Therefore, it is the necessary condition of the soul to be free of mortal sin and pleasing to God before reception of Holy Communion, otherwise the reception becomes a sacrilege. If a soul is not in this state, they should refrain from receiving Holy Communion and just receive a blessing instead until they have gone to Confession.
