

Commercial Kitchen Update

Approval has been given by the Chancery to construct the commercial kitchen in the parish hall. Fr. Tad has consulted with the Finance Committee and quotes were obtained. The total estimated cost of the project is \$180,026. "Family of Faith" donations totalling \$27, 878.27 will be used toward funding this project, the remainder will be funded by operating cash, and a chancery investment (\$109,539.41).
