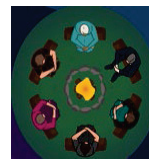
Blessing of Pets

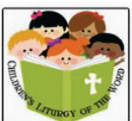

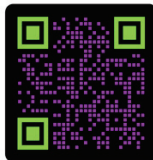
