Development and Peace Justice Petitions Make A Difference

In 2014, many parishes signed petitions that called specifically for mining justice, including the establishment of an independent ombudsperson.

On Jan. 17, 2018, the Federal Government announced the creation of the Canadian Ombudsperson for Responsible Enterprise (CORE). This office will help to ensure that the voices of people in the Global South who allege their human rights are violated by Canadian companies are heard. It will investigate allegations of abuse and make its findings public. The mandate will expand beyond extractives, like mining, oil, and gas, to include the garment industry, and eventually cover all business sectors operating internationally.
