Save Summer Jobs Campaign

Thousands of charities across Canada are feeling the impact of new application requirements for the Canada Summer Jobs program. To be eligible for funding, employers must affirm an attestation that both the job and the organization's core mandate respect certain "values" determined by the federal government. Organizations unable to endorse the attestation on moral grounds have been refused funding. In response to this situation, Cardinal Collins has sent out a letter asking concerned citizens to respectfully write to their Members of Parliament through a special website www.savesummerjobs.ca.

As the cardinal states: "We should all take note when a government claims to value the contributions of faith communities but requires them to profess a set of values which is against their faith in order to be eligible for government funding." Cardinal Collins is also personally writing to Members of Parliament in the local ridings where Catholic organizations were deemed ineligible due to their opposition to the attestation.
