An email scam previously reported by several other dioceses has now appeared in our own diocese with reports of at least one parishioner who lost \$300 to a fraudster pretending to be the pastor of a parish. Several other dioceses reported an email scam where Catholics have been hit by scammers sending requests, purportedly from their parish priests, for iTunes gift cards. A false email from a priest is sent asking for the electronic gift cards to be sent to another address so that they may be given to someone in need. Please advise caution when checking email messages. Always verify suspect messages by phoning the sender on a known phone number (not the phone number in the suspect message).
