<u>Marian Movement of Priests Cenacle – Beginning in September</u>

The first cenacle will be held on **Tuesday, September 14th following the 7 pm Mass**, led by Fr. Joseph Moncada who is the Spiritual Director for the Legion of Mary, Toronto Senatus.

Explanation: In her messages to Fr. Gobbi, Our Lady insistently calls us - priests, religious and faithful – to gather together with her in fervent prayer and fraternal love, in authentic cenacles as when the first apostles gathered with her in the Upper Room in Jerusalem awaiting the First Pentecost. Why this insistence? What is most important in the world and in the Church today is the preparation for the Second Pentecost through the triumph of her Immaculate Heart. To draw down upon us this gift of the Holy Spirit, we must enter with her into the cenacle.

Our Lady invites us to enter into the cenacle of her Immaculate Heart by means of our consecration. In the cenacle of her heart she will nourish, form, and help us to grow in perfect consecration to her. She calls us to form cenacles together with her and to multiply and spread them everywhere so that the Divine Spirit of Love may pass through the golden door of her Immaculate Heart and thus prepare humanity for a new era of grace and holiness.

Structure: The cenacle is comprised of an invocation to the Holy Spirit, the recitation of the Most Holy Rosary, Holy Hour and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament, and reading and commentary on Our Lady's messages contained in the book "To the Priests our Lady's Beloved Sons."

Date and Time: After the September 14th cenacle, all future cenacles will take place on the first Tuesday of the month following the 7 pm Mass and will end at approximately 8:45 pm.

Empowering men to take the next step in authentic male leadership, TMIY: The Battle Over the Bride focuses on their role as husband and their deep desire for self-sacrificial love. Offering proven solutions and practical methods, it provides an incredible clear pathway to overcoming pressures men encounter in going to the end of love. The program is divided into two, 13-week sessions. The Fall session emphasizes the Church's vision of love and marriage, while the Spring session emphasizes the practical means of achieving that vision.

The program will be hosted every Saturday virtually on Zoom, and potentially in-person at St. Mark's Church, beginning on September 11th. We will gather at 8 am for a presentation that combines the best scientific research with the teachings of the Church and wisdom of the saints. It's followed at 8:30am with breakout groups that provide the opportunity to discuss what's been presented. We will end no later than 9am.
