Adoration will resume again on Friday, February 4<sup>th</sup> from 9 am to 1 pm.

**St. Mark's is offering two Communion Services** for those who cannot physically attend church due to restricted capacity. For the next three months on the First Sunday of the month- **Feb 6, Mar 6, April 3,** St. Mark's offers a Communion Service **at 1:00 pm and again at 1:30pm.**

No registration required- first come until we reach capacity. At the door, we will record your contact info for potential contact tracing. **We ask that you please arrive at least 15 minutes early to sign-in.**

We hope you will be able to watch Mass the same weekend on Livestream or recognized media source and then come to St. Mark's to receive Jesus or a blessing at the Communion Service on the first Sunday of the month. Protocols such as masks and social distancing will apply.
