For the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, we invite parishioners to come and spend some quiet time of worship and prayer with Our Lord during our 30 Hour Adoration beginning on <u>Friday, June 11th at 6 am and finishing on Saturday, June 12th at 12 noon</u>. We will need to have at least 3 people scheduled for each hour during the night period from 10 pm to 6 am. If we do not get this commitment, we will have to drop the night hours and make it a 15 hour Eucharistic Adoration on June 11 from 6 am to 9 pm and another two and a half hours on Saturday morning from 9:30 am to 12 noon concluding with Benediction.

I long for the attention of your heart and for the consolation of your adoration, your reparation, and your love...Do what I have asked you to do. Live in adoration and reparation, and in thanksgiving for the inestimable gifts of the Sacrament of My love and of the priesthood. Seek Me out and remain before My Eucharistic Face, close, very close to My open Heart. I will do all the rest. Adore Me. Make reparation. Approach Me and remain with Me."
