It will require becoming familiar with the Chosen Program and the DVD segments, running two training evenings for the small group leaders, and attending and leading the 9 classes that take place on Wednesday evenings in the months of January to March. Also, coordinating the retreat in April. The ideal person will be familiar with using the Zoom platform and other programs and technology. Volunteers

Our Confirmation Program is set to begin in January. A number of parents have volunteered to help with the preparatory classes for the children; however, we are still in need of 3 or 4 more volunteers to allow the program to run smoothly.

You do not need to be an expert in Catechism to become a volunteer: you will be given a copy of the Leader's Guide, as well, the program coordinator will train you. You need only to be willing to engage with the youth and to do your best.

Volunteers will lead a group of 7-8 young people via Zoom. Throughout the program, the candidates view DVD segments related to the faith and the Sacrament of Confirmation. The volunteers then facilitate discussions in their small group about what was presented in the DVD.

Requirements

- Two Training Sessions the first will take place on January 6 via Zoom
- Approximately a half an hour of preparation for each class to review material to be discussed
- One and a half hours on the day of each class (there are 9 online classes that run on Wednesday evenings in the months of January to March and a retreat day in April)
