### \*\*IMPORTANT CONFIRMATION PREPARATION REGISTRATION INFORMATION\*\*

June 20, 2025

Re: Celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation / Year 2025-2026

Dear Parent(s):

You are receiving this letter because you have a child who will be entering **Grade 7** in the fall of 2025, and therefore, I wanted to take this opportunity to provide you with some information about the Parish based, **Immediate Preparation Program** for the sacrament of Confirmation next year.

**Please note** that this Sacrament of Confirmation is to be celebrated and **received in the family's home parish** (i.e., the parish where the family attends Sunday Mass).

Young people learn their faith first and foremost from their parents. It is in the home that they first learn about God and are introduced to the Christian way of life. This is considered the *initial preparation* for receiving the sacrament of Confirmation. Those who attend Catholic schools participate in religious education, which is also part of this initial preparation, as is coming to Church each Sunday to worship God, to celebrate the memorial of His Passion and Death, and thereby, thank God our Father for all His blessings, especially for the gift of His only Son, Jesus.

As the time for receiving the sacrament of Confirmation nears, the candidate may begin the process of <u>Immediate</u> <u>Preparation</u> for the sacrament which takes place in the parish.

**Immediate Preparation** for the sacrament of Confirmation will be accomplished through a combined effort of the candidates themselves, their parents, school, and St. Mark's Parish:

**Role of Parents:** The first role of parents is to help their child understand what is required in making the important commitment to deepen their relationship with God and His only begotten Son and receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Parents should help their child by encouraging them to remember that in Confirmation we receive the fullness of God's Spirit so as to be His disciples and witnesses in this world and to be able to participate more fully in the blessings of Heaven.

Furthermore, parents are responsible for helping their child discern if this is something they can commit to this year. If your son or daughter has commitments for the fall/winter seasons, such as recreational activities, vacation trips, family functions, etc. and therefore, they will not be able to fully commit and dedicate the required time to the program, they can defer receiving this sacrament until Grade 8 or high school.

It is expected, of course, that the candidate and their families commit to attending the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass each weekend. It is the best opportunity for our children to understand their faith, and to see you leading by example which is the most important lesson and gift you can give them.

Once they are registered and classes begin, the candidates will be required to **complete a Journal at each weekend Mass** for the duration of the Confirmation program. We will provide further information in the fall as to how these will be submitted.

Attendance at all classes is absolutely mandatory. <u>Should the candidate miss more than one of the preparatory</u> <u>classes leading up to Confirmation, he or she will not be able to proceed.</u> Prior notice of absence must be given in advance. If one class is missed, a makeup package will have to be completed at home.

*Role of Schools:* The Catholic schools will continue to teach the curriculum as it relates to religious instruction for grade 7 students.

#### Role of St. Mark's Parish – Program, Class and Confirmation Celebration Dates:

St. Mark's Parish will be providing the **Immediate Confirmation Preparation Program**. The team established to lead this program will consist of several members of our parish community including our Youth Minister, parent, parish, and student volunteers, myself, and our deacons.

#### Program, Ceremony and Retreat Dates

I have attached a <u>summary of proposed tentative dates</u> related to the Confirmation program. Please note that I will not be able to confirm these dates until after school begins in September – this letter is simply intended to give you as much **advance notice** as possible and to make you aware of the time commitments for both your child and your family in connection with receiving this Sacrament.

#### **Volunteers**

Volunteering is a wonderful opportunity for you to share more deeply in this grace filled journey to Confirmation with your child. We encourage parents to consider volunteering to co-lead a group of approximately 7-8 young people for the sessions that will take place in the parish hall at St. Mark's Church. Throughout the program, the candidates view video segments related to the faith and the sacrament of Confirmation. The volunteers then facilitate discussions in their small group about what was presented in the video. Many people who have volunteered with this program in the past have returned to assist in years when they don't have any children in the program because they found it to be such a rewarding experience.

You do not need to be an expert in Catechism to become a volunteer: you will be given a copy of the Leader's Guide, as well, our program coordinators are here to help and train you. You need only to be willing to engage with the youth and to do your best. You have a wealth of experiences that will benefit the youth in your group.

#### Requirements

- One Training Session in January
- Approximately a half an hour of preparation for each class to review material to be discussed
- One and a half hours on the day of each class

#### **Conclusion**

I look forward to sharing with you in this God-given mission of leading our children to the Father through His Son in the Holy Spirit.
